

Mobile Vaccination Clinic Available to Provide Free On-Site Immunizations for your Community, Organization, or Workplace

The Mobile Vaccination Clinic was developed in partnership with Alberta Health and the Industry for Vaccination (IFV), which is a coalition of companies supporting Alberta's vaccine rollout.

It is ready to provide on-site immunization for any community, organization, workplace, etc. in Alberta, recognizing that putting vaccines where people are is critical for uptake.

There are no costs associated with the Mobile Vaccination Clinic — our goal is simply to support the immunization of as many Albertans as possible.

Commonly Asked Questions

Who is providing the immunizations?

The bus is staffed by highly trained healthcare professionals from ACESO with extensive experience providing COVID vaccinations.

How does the Mobile Vaccination Clinic work with existing immunizers like AHS and pharmacies?

We work closely with all immunizing partners and follow the same Alberta government standards for vaccine record-keeping, safety, and quality. The Mobile Vaccination Clinic is designed to meet people where they are to make immunization easier.

Who can access the Mobile Vaccination Clinic?

This is open to all groups in Alberta — municipalities, businesses, community organizations, faith groups, and many more. As the clinic is mobile, we can go to any part of Alberta, including rural and remote areas.

How many vaccines can be delivered by the Mobile Vaccination Clinic?

We can deliver up to 300 vaccinations per day, which should meet the needs of most organizations.

Is there any cost associated with accessing the Mobile Vaccination Clinic?

No, there are absolutely no costs with accessing the clinic in the same way that there is no cost to getting vaccinated at an AHS clinic, pharmacy, or your family doctor.

What identification is required?

Bring your Alberta Health Care card and one piece of identification that proves your age to the clinic. This could include your driver's license, Social Insurance Number, birth certificate, or passport.

What if I don't have an Alberta Health Care card?

Not a problem. Please bring one piece of identification that proves your age to the clinic.

How do I bring the clinic to my community or worksite?
