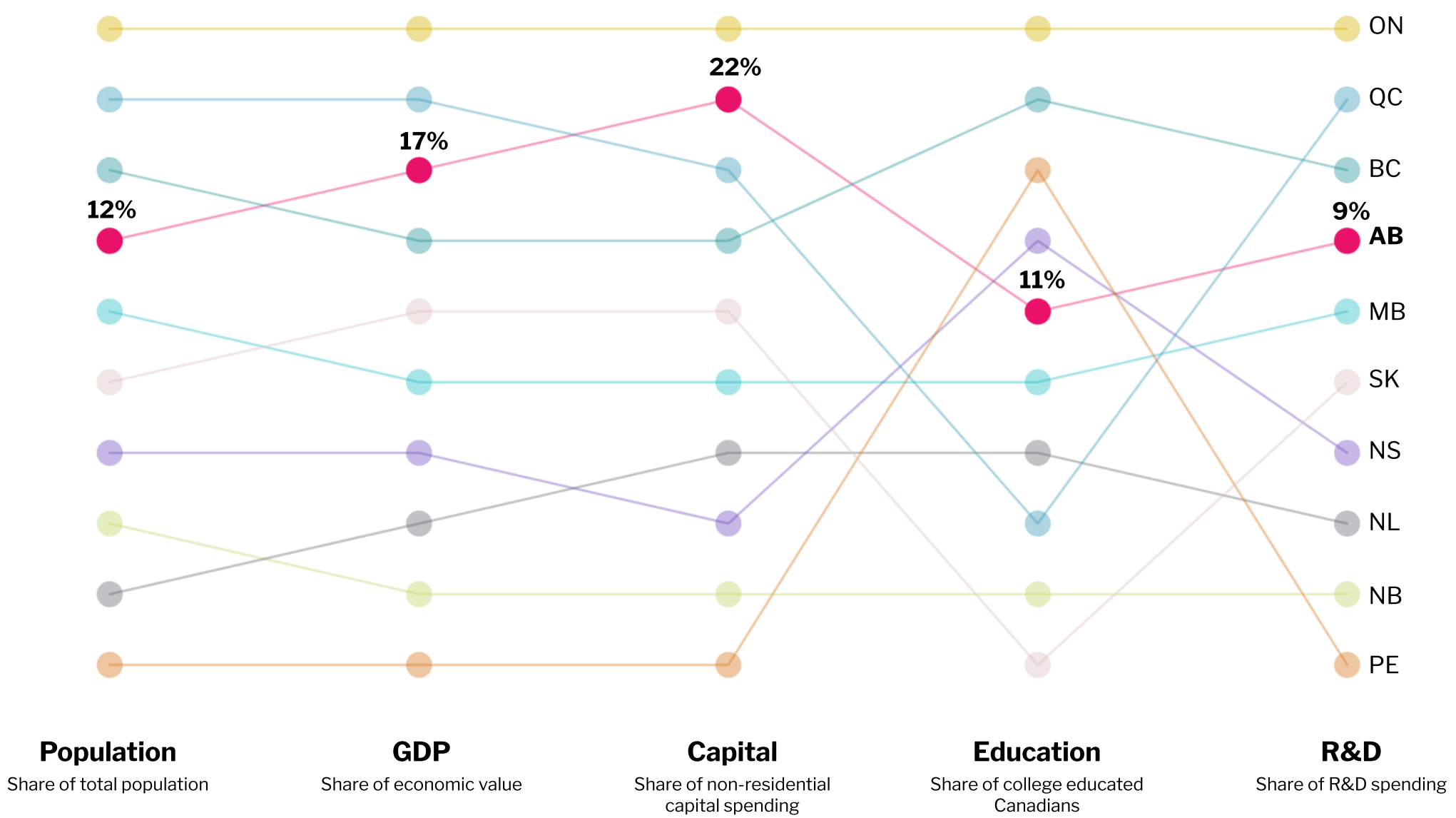


How Alberta ranks compared to the rest of Canada

Alberta's ranking pre-pandemic



- The latest data pre-pandemic show Alberta accounts for an outsized share of economic value and capital spending in Canada.
- Alberta does not, however, account for an outsized share of college-educated Canadians or R&D spending.
- 53% of Albertans (age 25 and over) have received at least some college education, the fifth-highest across provinces. Meanwhile, ON and BC excel in producing and/or attracting highly educated individuals.
- On R&D spending—an important driver of innovation and future growth—Alberta ranks fourth and accounts for just 9%.
